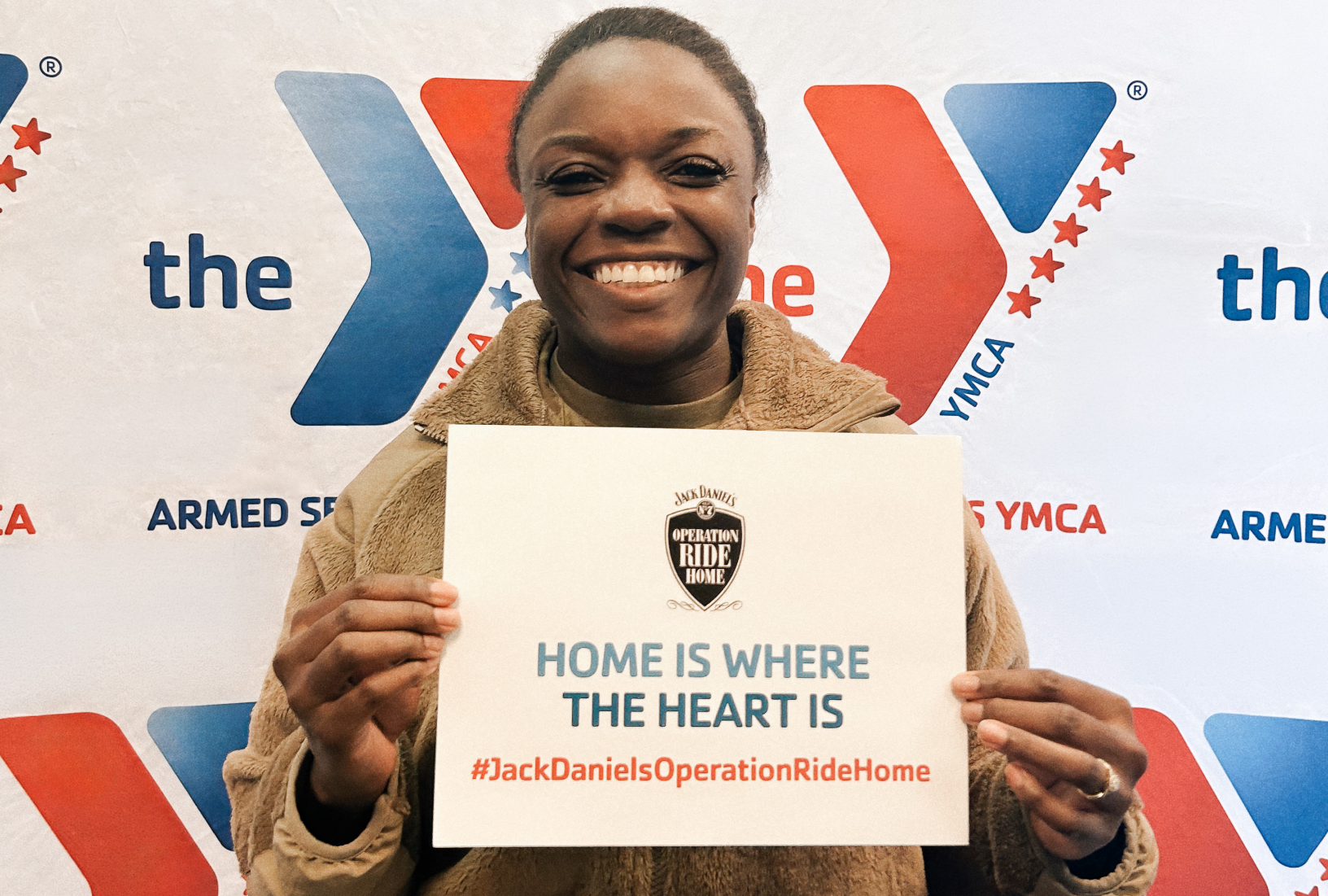

EXTRA CREDIT FOR YOUR CLASSROOM

Statewide | Classroom Teachers

Local classroom teachers with an Active Duty Military ID and Teacher ID can receive a \$25 ASYMCA voucher for Ft. Wainwright, Ft. Richardson, and Elmendorf Bargain Shops. Classroom teachers can use their vouchers on classroom supplies, educational materials, books, organization tools, and learning resources.

Spend the holidays with family! The Jack Daniel's and ASYMCA Operation Ride Home program helps junior enlisted active-duty service members and military families with holiday travel costs. Applications are accepted August 10–

September 6, with selected participants receiving up to a \$500 per person flight stipend. Open to active duty stationed in Alaska only. Participants will be notified by September 23.

WINTER GEAR UP

Statewide | All Ranks

Get your child ready for the Alaska winter with ASYMCA's Winter Gear Up! We want school-age children to be as active in the winter as they are in the summer. This program prepares school-age military children for enjoying the outdoors with play-approved snow gear at no cost to military families. Winter Gear Up is made possible through our partners, Delta Air Lines and Big Ray's. Registration for each child is required and is available online for all duty stations in Alaska.

Note: Ranks E1–E5 have priority registration August 10–15. Open to all ranks on August 16.

Military families in remote Alaska locations can participate in Winter Gear Up through our partnership with Delta Air Lines and Big Ray's. We want school age children to be as active in the winter as they are in the summer. Eligible families can request snow gear to help children stay warm and enjoy outdoor play throughout the winter. Registration is required for each child and is available at alaska.asymca.org.
